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STRENGTH & CONDITIONING CAMP

Cost: High School-\$200 for 4 days/week

Location of Camp: Meet downstairs by the weight room/coaches office in St. Mary High School each morning.

Cardinal Strength and Conditioning Camp for Senior High (Grades 9-12 next year):

This camp meets Monday thru Friday of each week. This is an 11-week camp starting in late May. This camp is for both boys and girls. The goal of the camp is to improve speed, strength, agility, coordination, and flexibility. (Calendars will be emailed out once sign up is done and amount of sessions have been set.)
